

#### **THE EPISTLE:** St. Paul to the Corinthians. (8:8-9:2)

Brethren, food will not commend us to God. We are no worse off if we do not eat, and no better off if we do. Only take care, lest this liberty of yours somehow become a stumbling block to the weak. For if any one sees you—a man of knowledge—at table in an idol's temple, might he not be encouraged, if his conscience is weak, to eat food offered to idols? And so by your knowledge this weak man is destroyed, the brother for whom Christ died. Thus, sinning against your brethren and wounding their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ. Therefore, if food is a cause of my brother's falling, I will never eat meat, lest I cause my brother to fall. Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord? Are not you my workmanship in the Lord? If to others I am not an apostle, at least I am to you; for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord.

#### الرسالة: اكورنثوس ٨: ٨-١٣، ٩: ١-٢

يا إخوة إنّ الطعام لا يُقرّبنا إلى الله، لأنّا إن أكلنا لا نزيد وإن لم نأكل لا ننقص. ولكن انظروا ألّا يكون سلطانكم هذا معثرة للضعفاء، لأنّه إن رآك أحدٌ، يا من له العلْم، متّكلًا في بيت الأوثان، أفلا يتقوّى ضميرُه وهو ضعيف على أكل ذبائح الأوثان، فيهلك بسبب علْمك الأخُ الضعيف الذي مات المسيخ لأجله. وهكذا إذ تُخطئون إلى الإخوة وتجرحون ضمائرهم وهي ضعيفة إنّما تخطئون إلى المسيح. فلذلك إن كان الطعام يُشكّكُ أخي فلا آكل لحمًا إلى الأبد لئلّا أشكّك أخي. ألستُ أنا رسولًا؟ ألستُ أنا حرًا؟ أما رأيتُ يسوع المسيح ربّنا؟ ألستم أنتم عملي في الربّ؟ وإن لم أكن رسولًا إلى آخرين فإنّي رسول إليكم، لأنّ خاتم رسالتي هو أنتم في الربّ.

#### THE GOSPEL: St. Matthew. (25:31-46)

The Lord said, "When the Son of man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. Before Him will be gathered all the nations, and He will separate them one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and He will place the sheep at His right hand, but the goats at the left. Then the King will say to those at His right hand,

'Come, O blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave Me food, I was thirsty and you gave Me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed Me, I was naked and you clothed Me, I was sick and you visited Me, I was in prison and you came to Me.' Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry and feed Thee, or thirsty and give Thee drink? And when did we see Thee a stranger and welcome Thee, or naked and clothe Thee? And when did we see Thee sick or in prison and visit Thee?' And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.' Then He will say to those at his left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave Me no food, I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome Me, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.' Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to Thee?' Then He will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to Me.' And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

#### Metropolitan Anthony: SUNDAY OF THE LAST JUDGEMENT

Today, on our preparation journey towards Lent, we have come to an ultimate stage: we are confronted with judgment. If we pay attention to it, next week our spiritual destiny will be in our own hands, because next week is the day of Forgiveness.

The link between these two days is too obvious. If we only could become aware that all and each of us stand before the judgment of God and the judgment of men, if we could remember and realize with depth, wholeheartedly, in earnest that we are, all of us, indebted to each other, all responsible to each other for some of the pain and the heaviness of life, then we would find it easy, when we are asked to forgive, not only to forgive, but, in response to this request, to ask for forgiveness ourselves.

It is not only by what we do, not only in a way by what we leave undone, it is by this extraordinary lack of awareness, of our responsibility, of all we could be to others, and to do to others, that we do not fulfill our human vocation. We could, and we should, on all levels and for all men, and beyond men for the whole world which is ours, be a blessing and a revelation of things great, of things so great, so deep that people, we first of all, could realise that we are on the scale of God Himself, that our vocation is not only to be morally good, but to be as great as God. A mystic of Germany said in one of his poems 'I am as great as God, God is as small as I.'

If we only could remember this, and this is why the judgment is not only a moment when we are confronted with a danger of condemnation; there is in the very notion of judgment something great and inspiring. We are not going to be judged according to human standards of behavior of decency. We are going to be judged according to standards which are beyond human ordinary life. We are going to be judged on the scale of God, and the scale of God is love: not love felt, not an emotional love, but love lived and accomplished. The fact that we are going to be judged, that indeed we are being judged all the time, above our means, beyond all our smallness must, should reveal to us our potential greatness. And the parable which we have read today can be seen in those very terms: men are judged by Christ, in His parable, on humanity. Have these men been human or not? Have they known how to love in their hearts first, but also in action, in their very deeds because, as Saint John puts it, one who says that he loves God and does not love his neighbor actively, creatively is a liar. There is no love of God if it is not expressed in every detail of our relationship with men, with people and with each person.

And so, let us this week prepare ourselves for the final stage of our journey by asking ourselves in the face of this divine judgment, 'Am I human? Am I human within myself, in my behavior - not my general attitude, but my ways: are they human? Is my life an expression of a fine, a thoughtful, a perceptive, a creative, and at times a generous and a sacrificial love?' As the object of love is the test of this love, it must be my neighbor; to love God who asks for nothing is too easy.

And if in the course of this week we find where we belong, we find both our shortcomings and the greatness of our vocation; if we make our peace with those to whom we are indebted, then, when the time comes to forgive, when someone else will have made the same discovery, we will be able with joy to give peace and forgiveness out of a sense of responsibility and of the creative joy of repentance.

سوف نمثُل أمام وجهه الكريم، وسوف نَمثُل مسحورين بجمال هذا الوجه إن سلّطنا أنواره علينا منذ الآن، أي إن دِنًا أنفسنا الآن، وإن جعلناه هو الصديق المحبّ الحبيب، وإن كنّا معه في إلفة ووُدّ، إذ ذاك يرفع عنا الدينونة ليضُمّنا إلى صدره الأبوي. ولكن إن أردنا هنا أن نتعبّد لأنفسنا وأن نحب ذواتنا على الفقراء، عندئذ نكون قد دِنّا أنفسنا. الله لا يدين ولكن الحقيقة تدين، الحقيقة سوف تظهر كاملة وسوف نُعَرّى ونشاهد أنفسنا إمّا عُشراء الله أو أعداء الله، ولذلك لنا منذ الآن أن ندخل في هذه المعاشرة الحلوة الطيّبة حتى لا نكون معادين.

على ماذا نُدان؟ ماذا سيتكشّف منا عند ذاك؟ كلمة واحدة قالها يسوع: إن أُحببتم المحتاجين تكونوا قد أحببتموني، وإن نسيتموهم أو لم تبصروهم تكونوا قد نسيتموني. ماذا نفعل الآن في الدنيا؟ شيئًا واحدًا فتّاكًا نفعله: المريض لا نراه، والسجين لا نراه، والفقير لا

لذلك سوف يحاكمنا المسيح لأننا لم نُبصر، لأننا لم نرَ الفقراء حيث هم، لم نرَ المريض مرميا على سرير المرض، ولم نرَ الجاهل يفتُك فيه الجهل، ولم نبصر الخاطئ، وبقينا مرتاحين. «ويل للمستريحين في صهيون وللمطمئنين» (عاموس ٦: ١). هكذا قال الأنبياء: كلّ فقير سوف يُطلب منّا، كل مريض وكل محتاج. فالناس في وحدة وهُم بحاجة إلى الحب. كلّهم محرومون محبّة وحنانا. الإنسان الذي لا يرى الحنان من حوله يحيا في عزلة رهيبة. كل إنسان يعيش في عزلة، كل إنسان وحده.

المؤمن ليس فقط من يلتفت إلى الله، فالله ليس بحاجة الينا. نصلي ليس لأنه بحاجة، لكن لنربح نحن، لنستفيد من حوار نُقيمه معه. نريد الصلاة لكي يروّضنا الله على الحب. الله ليس بحاجة إلى الدعاء، نحن بحاجة إلى الدعاء.

ولكن، إن التفتنا إلى وجه الله، يردُّنا وجهه إلى وجوه الناسُ. فالله يريدنا أن نكون مع الناس، ويريدنا في الدرجة الأولى أن نجعل الإنسان الوحيد المعزول ألا يحسّ بعزلته. هذه خبرة لنا جميعًا. ليس من إنسان يُحَبّ بقدر كاف، ولهذا أعطُوا وتدفقوا. أعطوا كل يوم ساعات من الحب للناس الذين من حولكم حتى لا يعيشوا محرومين. وعندئذ لن يدينكم الله بل يرفعكم أمام وجهه فوق كل شيء، ويضمّكم إلى صدره.
