

Matthew: (9:1-8)

At that time, Jesus got into a boat, crossed over and came to His own city. And behold, they brought to Him a paralytic, lying on his bed; and when Jesus saw their faith He said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves, "This man is blaspheming." But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—

He then said to the paralytic—"Rise, take up your bed and go home." And he rose and went home. When the crowds saw it, they marveled, and they glorified God, Who had given such authority to men.

في ذلكَ الزمان، دَخَلَ يَسوعُ السَفينَةَ واجْتازَ وجاءَ إلى مَدينَتِهِ. فَإِذَا بِمُخَلَّعِ مُلْقى على سَريرِ قَدَّموهُ إليهِ. فَلَمّا رَأَى يَسوعُ إيمانَهُمْ، قالَ لِلْمُخَلَّعِ: "ثق يا بُنَيّ، مَغْفورَةٌ لَكَ خَطاياك." فَقالَ قَوْمٌ مِنَ الكَتَبَةِ في أَنْفُسِهِمْ "هذا يُجَدِّفُ." فَعَلِمَ يَسوعُ أَفْكارَهُمْ، فَقالَ: "لِماذا تُفَكِّرونَ بالشَرّ في قُلوبِكُمْ؟ مَا الأَيْسَرُ أَنْ يُقالَ، مَغْفورَةٌ لَكَ خَطاياك، أَمْ أَنْ يُقالَ قُمْ فَامْشِ؟ ولَكِنْ لِكَيْ تَعْلَموا أَنَّ ابْنَ البَشَر لَهُ سُلْطانٌ عَلى الأَرْضِ أَنْ يَغْفِرَ الخَطايا. (حينَئِذٍ قالَ لِلْمُخَلِّع) "قُمْ، احْمِلْ سَريرَكَ واذْهَبْ إلى بَيْتِكَ." فَقامَ ومَضمَى إلى بَيْتِهِ. فَلَمّا نَظَرَ الجُموعُ، تَعَجَّبُوا ومَجَدوا الله الذي أَعْطى الناسَ سُلُطاناً كَهَذَا.

READING THE SIGNS OF THE TIMES

In the Gospel (Matthew 16: 3), Christ advises His disciples to learn to read the signs of the times. Can we read the signs of the times? Have we received this message, this calling compelling us to look at what the times say to us?

Our times say something which is very worrying: while centuries back the Christian Church proclaimed its message in a credible, acceptable way, while people who heard the message did

receive it and believed it, it seems that our message reaches only the few. It is not because the truth has changed, or because we must preach another Gospel than the integrity of the Gospel of Christ. Saint John of the Ladder says that the word of God is like a straight and pointed arrow, it can fly straight to its goal, it can hit the target, it can pierce any thickness and any resistance. But Saint John tells us also that the arrow will remain useless and dormant unless there is an arm, a bow, a string, an eye, unless there is an eye to aim the shaft, unless there is a vigorous arm to send it flying.

The arrow straight and pointed is God's message which we are to deliver to the whole world that it may be saved, as straight as the integrity of the Gospel - but have we got all God needs from us for this arrow to fly and hit the target? Is it not that the word of God remains unconvincing because looking at us people see no evidence that it has any power to transform life?

And here, we must read the signs of the times. The times, the people around us, the world is standing in judgment over us. Why is it that words of truth do not sound true? Why is it that words of life do not convey and impart life? Because we have not been hit in such a way as to possess life, as to be able to proclaim truth.

I would like to leave this thought with you, and each of us can ask himself what is the message he received from the Gospel, what is the life he had derived from it? What is the truth that has become the truth of his life? And only then can our message convey to men what God had imparted to us and commanded us to carry.

القاعدة الأخلاقية

يدور في أذهان الناس أنّ الوصايا العشر تحتوي كلّ الأخلاق المسيحيّة. الحقيقة أنّها نموذج وأنّ ثمّة خطايا كثيرة لا تذكرها هذه الوصايا. أضف إلى أنّ الوصية الثانية: «احفظ يوم السبت لتقدّسه» هي أمر طقوسيّ يهوديّ ولم نبق مرتبطين به فالربّ بقيامته حرّرنا من يوم السبت. وإقلاعنا نحن عن العمل يوم الأحد ليس وصيّة إلهيّة. هو ترتيب كنسيّ، والأصل فيه إقامة القدّاس الإلهيّ. في العهد القديم عينه القاعدة الأشمل هي هذه: «أحبب الربّ إلهك حبّك لنفسك» (لاويّين ١٩: ١٨). هذه اتّخذها يسوع: «أحبب الربّ إلهك بكلّ قلبك وبكلّ نفسك وبكلّ ذهنك. تلك هي الوصيّة الأولى والكبرى». وبعد هذا أضاف: «والثانية مثلها: أحبب قريبك حبّك لنفسك» (متّى العبل عبيرة عليه والمربعة عليه والمحبّة. ولكن ما الرباط بين هذه الوصيّة الجديدة والوصايا العشر؟ هنا يوضح بولس: «مَن أحبّ غيره أنتم الشريعة. فإنّ الوصايا التي تقول: «لا ترنّ، لا تقتل، لا تسرق، لا تشته» وسواها من الوصايا، مجتمعة في هذه الكلمة: «أحبب قريبك حبّك لنفسك». فالمحبّة لا تُنزل بالقريب شرًّا، فالمحبّة إذًا كمال الشريعة» (رومية ١٤: ٨-١٠).

قد يبدأ الإنسان بالمحافظة على الشرائع، ثمّ إذا عرف يسوع يفهم أنّ قدرتنا على إتمامها تأتي من نعمة الله. فحتّى لا تكون الوصايا سيفًا مصلتًا فوق رأس الإنسان ينبغي أن تنبع من القلب الذي استضاء بنور المسيح. هذا هو العهد الجديد الذي تحدّث عنه إرمياء بقوله: «وأُسكنهم في الطمأنينة، فيكونون لي شعبًا وأكون لهم إلهًا، وأُعطيهم قلبًا

و احدًا... و أقطّع معهم عهدًا أبديًّا أنّي لا أرجع عنهم» (٣٢: ٣٧_٠٠). فلكون الروح القدس ساكنًا فينا ونعرف الطمأنينة التي لنا من الله ننفّذ كلّ كلمة منه. فإذا صارت كلمة فينا تنبع هي بالعمل الصالح.

نحن صرنا في ملكوت المسيح وفي سيادته عليناً، في ذوقنا لحبّه لنا نعمل ما يرضيه وهذا يعطينا الفرح. عند ظهور الملكوت بالمسيح أعطانا يسوع شرعة الملكوت المكثّفة في إنجيل متّى في ما يُسمى عظة الجبل الواردة في الإصحاحات الـ٥ والـ٦ والـ٧ وما يقابلها في إنجيل لوقا.

هذه تبدأ بالتطويبات: «طوبى للمساكين بالروح». يسوع لا يأتي بشريعة لا يعرف العهد القديم أصولها. إنّه جاء ليكمل تلك. يسوع يحقّق النبوءة ويصل بها إلى كمالها. يجعلها ممكنة بالحبّ الذي هو أعطاه. يسوع يملأ الشريعة القديمة ويربطها بسرّ الحبّ. كانت وصيّة فوق الإنسان. الآن تأتى من الإنسان الذي أسلم نفسه للسيّد.

يسوع يصل إلى الجذور. «سمعتم أنّه قيل للأوّلين: «لا تقتل...» أمّا أنا فأقول لكم: مَن غضب على أخيه استوجب حكم القضاء». كذلك: «سمعتم أنّه قيل «لا تزنّ»، أمّا أنا فأقول لكم: مَن نظر إلى امرأة بشهوة، زنى بها في قلبه». المسألة ليست أن نمتنع عن شيء خارجيّ بل أن نطهر القلب كيلا يميل إلى السوء.

من هناً أنّ الأخلاق المسيحيّة تقوم على أن يروّض الإنسان نفسه على أن تحبّ السيّد وأن يراقبها حتّى تمتنع عن الخطيئة وتحبّ الخير. إذ ذاك، الوصايا تنبع تلقائيًا من القلب المتطهّر.
