

Metropolitan Anthony Healing of Bartimeus



We are coming now to the weeks of preparation for Lent. Habitually on this particular week we read the Gospel of the Blind man. This story is that where Mark and Luke tell us about the blind man, a man who have tried everything to be healed, his own and other people's wisdom and ability, in vain, and who in the end found that Christ was passing by. Christ had not come to him, He was just passing along the road where the blind man was seated, begging, because there was nothing left to him. He did not expect any more healing or anything" only to survive. And then hope flared up in him: someone was passing, and this crowd had a peculiar sound, it was not a caravan, it was not people who were just walking along the road; it had a centre, a focus, there was something peculiar about this crowd. And he asked who it was, and when he heard Who it was, he began to cry for help. And Christ gave him help: He restored his sight, He cured his blindness.

Looking at this story don't we learn something very important? Our soul is sick, our life is waning" I am speaking of eternal life, perhaps not the life of our body; something is dying in us, and we should learn from David the King to cry out of the deep, the deep of our despair, the deep of our disillusionment, the deep of our misery, the deep of our sin, the deep of all the things that destroy us, cry a cry, aand say, I trust you, Lord! I trust your silence, as I would trust your word... And then, if we only abandon ourselves to that confidence, we will hear the Lord saying, See again! Go home, worry no more "home meaning the very depth of your being, the place where you are alive, because your soul is alive, life has come back!

Let us enter into these weeks of preparation with this glorious encouragement from God Himself, with this hope He gives us, this certainty, indeed He gives us. Let us start on this journey, and be ready when Lent comes to have gone from blindness to sight.

And next week, when we remember Zaccheus, let us remember him again with eyes that can see, and then go on, from strength to strength, from brokenheartedness to brokenheartedness, and from sickness to healing, until we come to the Resurrection.

الخطأة الذين أنا أولهم

من هو تيموثاوس الذي أرسلت اليه رسالتان؟ من أعمال الرسل نرى ان بولس لقي هذا الشاب في لسترة وجعله معاونه الأمثل. كان أبوه يونانيا اي وثنيا وكانت أمه يهودية واعتنقت الإيمان المسيحي وتعلّم الكتب المقدسة اي العهد القديم منذ نعومة أظفاره. كانت تنتابه وعكات كثيرة واهتم بولس لصحته وختنه لتجنب المتاعب التي يثيرها المسيحيون المتهودون. ورسمه مشايخ الكنيسة. الرسالات الرعائية وهذه منها تعكس لاهوت بولس.

في الرسالة الأولى الى تيموثاوس يقول معلّمه بولس أن "صادقة هي الكلمة وجديرة بكل قبول" وهي كلمة التي كان يعلّمها الرسول ويسمّيها إنجيله أي ذلك الذي أخذه مباشرة من السيد منذ ظهوره له على الطريق المستقيم، وهي أن المسيح جاء ليخلّص الخطأة اي نحن جميعا، ثم يعرّف نفسه على انه أوّل الخطأة وهي الكلمة التي على كل واحد منا أن يقولها عن نفسه، اذ ليس لأحد منا أن يقارن نفسه بالآخرين فلا يقول عن نفسه أنا أفضل من هذا وذاك بهذه الفضيلة او تلك، و عليه أن يرى نفسه آخر الناس لأن الرب وحده يدين سرائر الناس حسب إنجيلي (والكلمة لبولس) بيسوع المسيح.

فليس لأيّ إنسان أن يقول عن نفسه إلا أن الرحمة تنزل عليه وتنقذه من كلّ خطيئة. واذا رحمه الرب، يكون هذا بطول أناته. عند ذاك يرى الناس رحمة الرب عليه ويعرفون انها ستنزل عليهم لينالوا الحياة الأبدية التي تبدأ بالمعمودية وتبقى معنا في الأسرار المقدسة والإيمان.

"فلمَلِك الدهور الذي لا يعروه فساد ولا يُرى، الله الحكيم وحده، الكرامة والمجد الى دهر الداهرين". هذه هي حركة اختطافنا اليه في التسبيح. الحركة الأولى نحو الله هي السؤال او الطلب. واذا نلنا الطلب الذي يكون لخلاصنا، نشكره. وهذه هي الحركة الثانية نحو الله. وبعد هذا لا يبقى الا التسبيح.

هذه الحركات الثلاث هي الصلاة. نتوسل او لا لنيل ما هو للخلاص. لنا أن نطلب الصحة ووسائل العيش دون أن ننسى أنها تقودنا الى الله. الصحة والطعام والشراب ليست غاية. هي طريق الى خلاص النفس وتنقيتها. هذا وحده السُكنى مع الله في هذا العالم والعالم الآتى. مُعاشر ثنا الرب في كل يوم هي الخلاص عينه.

أن نعيش في طلب الغفران في التواضع نتيجة قول الرب: "صلّوا في كل حين". نحن لا نستطيع أن نتلو الصلاة في كل حين، ولكنّا نطلب أن يرفع الرب قلوبنا اليه في كل حين. وهذه صلاة لا كلام فيها. واذا أدركنا هذه الدرجة في العلاقة مع الآب والابن والروح نكون في السماء منذ الآن، نصبح مسكن الله، أحرارا من كل شهوة مؤذية، منجذبين الى وجه الآب الذي هو البدء

و هذا لا يتحقق لأحد ما لم ير نفسه مثل بولس "آخِر الناس"، اي اذا تواضعنا، والتواضع فضيلة ما من بعدها فضيلة. هي التي تؤهلنا أن نقول مع بولس ان المسيح جاء ليخلص الخطأة الذين أنا أوّلهم. عند ذاك يرفعنا الله الى عرشه.
