

#### **THE EPISTLE:** Romans (2:10-16)

Brethren, glory and honor and peace to everyone who does good, to the Jew first, and also to the Greek; for there is no respect of persons with God. 



### Metropolitan Anthony CALLING OF THE APOSTLES

It is essential for us to realise the link there is between Christ and the apostles. If you read the Gospels you will see that the apostles and the Lord Jesus Christ were born and lived in the same area. Christ came to live in Nazareth as a child; the apostles lived all about the place of His abode. We know nothing about the early years of these men, but if we think that Cana of Galilee was less than 4 miles away from Nazareth, if we think that all the cities and all the villages in which Peter and Andrew, John and others lived were around



the same place, we can imagine that they had met and seen and heard the Lord Jesus Christ as a child, as a youth.

We know nothing about the impact of His personality growing harmoniously into the fullness of His human stature, but links of personal knowledge and familiarity existed. The disciples of John the Baptist, Andrew and John, were the disciples of a cousin of the Lord. James was the brother of John, Peter was the brother of Andrew. When they first met Christ, they sought out their friends Nathanael and Phillip. Even the words of Nathanael 'Can anything good come out of Nazareth?' is not a mysterious saying. What would any one of us say if he was told that God Himself had become man in a village four miles away from his own village?

And then there is a whole process which we can trace in the Gospels in which one can see how, gradually, the disciples discover the Lord Jesus Christ, how He becomes gradually more and more to them. And one day their relatedness to Him is such that they could not leave Him even if they wanted to. When most of Christ's disciples abandoned Him the Lord said to the Twelve: 'Are you also going to go?' And Peter answers: 'Where should we go? Thou hast the word of eternal life'. This relatedness between the disciples and Christ that began perhaps in friendship, then in admiration grew to the relationship of disciples and Master, on the way to Caesarea Philippi becomes a recognition, proclaimed by one of them as a gift of God, of what He truly is: 'Thou art the Christ, the Son of the Living God'.

It is a relationship so deep, so perfect and complete that they cannot leave Him even if terror comes upon them. When Christ tells His disciples that He is going to Bethany because Lazarus has died, His disciples say: 'Are you going back into Judaea? Were not the Jews about to kill you?' And one of them says, 'Let us go with Him and die with Him'. And that one is Thomas, the one who so often is thought as a doubter. No, he is not a doubter. He is ready to live and to die with his Master, but he is not prepared credulously to receive the news of Christ's Resurrection with all its resurrecting impact and life-giving power without being sure — because when Christ died on the cross His disciples scattered, afraid, in hiding, and yet, attached to Him with all the fibres of their heart and mind and soul, they felt that life had gone out of the world, life had gone out of their lives. That happens to us when someone who is infinitely dear dies. Then we discover that because this person has died everything which is shallow, trivial, small, too small to be as great as life and death, becomes irrelevant. We turn away from it, we become as great as our perception of life and death can make us.

That is what happened to them, but then there was no life, there was only crushing,

وشهد البعض ليسوع في زمن الاضطهادات، فكانوا خير من صبر على العذابات والظلم والافتراء والحرمان، وخير من غلب الألم على أشكاله بالاتكال على الله والصلاة والرجاء، وخير من جسد حقيقة محبّة الله الباذلة للإنسان.

والبعض شهد ليسوع في تكريس الذات لله، في الصوم والصلاة والنسك، في حياة الشركة أو التوحّد الرهبانيّة، فكانوا خير مَن أظهر ثمار الروح القدس في نفوسهم وتعاليمهم، وخير مَن ألهم حياة المؤمنين في أزمنة المساومة على حقيقة الإنجيل والتماهي مع روح العالم، وخير مَن قاد النفوس من أرض العبوديّة للخطيئة إلى خدر الختن.

والبعض شهد ليسوع في رعاية الخراف الناطقة، في تقديس الحياة وعيش الأسرار والأبوّة الروحيّة، وكانوا خير مَن يسهر على أعضاء جسد المسيح، وخير مَن يحتمل ضعف الضعفاء، وخير مَن جعلوا أنفسهم كلّا للكلّ حتّى لا يبقى أحد خارج حظيرة المسيح. وشهد البعض ليسوع في مجال بشارة الكلمة وإيصالها إلى أترابهم، فكانوا خير مَن أنقذ أخًا أو شعبًا من جهل أو إلحاد أو خطيئة، وخير مَن أسّس كنيسة أو رعيّة تعيش هذه الحقيقة بالتوبة والصدة والصدة والخدمة.

وشهد البعض ليسوع في الحياة الزوجيّة وتربية الأولاد، فكانوا خير مثال في حفظ العفّة والأمانة، وخير مَن أنشأ على التقوى والبرّ والخدمة، وخير مَن بذل نفسه من دون حساب.

والبعض شهد ليسوع في الحياة المهنيّة، فكانوا خير مَن عملوا بمناقبيّة وضمير حيّ، وخير مَن جسّدوا إيمانهم في إعلاء خدمة القريب ونموّه، بعيدًا عن روح المنافسة والمجد الباطل والتسلّط ومحبّة المال.

والبعض شهد ليسوع في مجال الكفاح من أجل العدل والسلام والحقّ والمصالحة والإخاء، فكانوا خير مَن أنار الحياة العامّة بأن قدّموا ما لله لله وما لقيصر لقيصر، وأضاؤوا بالإيمان وروح الحكمة والالتزام كيفيّة خدمة الشأن العامّ وتعزيز الحياة المشتركة ونصرة الحقّ والعدل ورفع الظلم.

والبعض شهد ليسوع في مجالات الحياة على اختلافها، من علوم وآداب وإدارة وتربية وغيرها، فأنموا مواهبهم وخدموا بها أترابهم، وساعدوا على رقي الإنسان وتقدّم المجتمع وتكوين الحضارة، فأبرزوا معالم الوكيل الأمين الذي أقامه الله على خليقته. والبعض شهد ليسوع في الخفاء، فبقي غير منظور إلّا من الله ومن المتواضعين أو الودعاء أو المجاهدين مثله، فكانت لهؤلاء هذه الذكرى أيضًا سبيلًا لنكون معهم في شركة شكر وامتنان.

بفضل هؤلاء جميعًا تظهر أمامنًا ميادين عديدة نجسد فيها، على غرارهم، اعترافنا بيسوع قدّام الناس فيكلّل يسوع جهادنا بأن يعترف بنا قدّام أبيه الذي في السماوات (متّى ١٠: ٣٢). ونتلمّس، في الوقت عينه، كيف أنّ شهادتهم تدين تقاعسنا وكسلنا وجهلنا وضعف إيماننا ورياءنا (متّى ١٠: ٢٨)، طالما أنّهم أثبتوا لأترابهم، جيلًا بعد جيل، إمكانيّة رسم معالم ملكوت الله في وسط العالم، بحملهم صليب الالتزام ونكران الذات ومحبّتهم الصادقة للمسيح، ومن بعده، لكلّ إنسان وقريب (متّى ١٠: ٣٨-٣٨). ما أحلى هذا الطريق الذي شقّه لنا مَن سبقنا في محبّة الله والقريب وترجمها في ظروف الحياة على اختلافها! هلّا مَضَينا قدمًا في هذه المسيرة برجاء وامتنان؟
