

THE EPISTLE: Corinthians (3:9-17)

Brethren, we are God's fellow workers; you are God's husbandry, God's building. According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise architect I laid a foundation, and another builds upon it. Let each one take heed how he builds upon it. For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; everyone's work will become manifest; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire itself will test each one's work of what sort it is. If anyone's work which was built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, but he himself will be saved, yet so as by fire. Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone corrupts the temple of God, God will corrupt him. For the temple of God is holy, whose temple you are.

THE GOSPEL: Matthew (14:22-34)

At that time, Jesus made the Disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He dismissed the crowds. And after He had dismissed the crowds, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray. When evening came, He was there alone, but the Disciples' boat by this time was many furlongs distant from the land, beaten by the waves; for the wind was against them. And in the fourth watch of the night He came to them, walking on the sea. But when the Disciples saw Jesus walking on the sea, they were terrified, saying, "It is a ghost!" And they cried out for fear. But immediately He spoke to them, saying, "Take heart, it is I; have no fear." And Peter answered Him, "Lord, if it is Thee, bid me come to Thee on the water." He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus; but when he saw the wind, he was afraid, and beginning to sink he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Jesus immediately reached out His hand and caught him, saying to him, "O man of little faith, why did you doubt?" And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. And those in the boat worshiped Him, saying, "Truly, Thou art the Son of God." And when they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret.

الإنجيل: متى

في ذلك الزمان، اضطرَّ يسوعُ تلاميذهُ أَنْ يَدْخُلُوا السَفينةَ ويَسْبِقوهُ إلى العَبْرِ حَتِّى يَصْرِفَ الجُموع. ولمَّا صَرَفَ الجُموعَ، صَعِدَ وحْدَهُ إلى الجبلِ لِيُصَلِّى. ولَمَّا كانَ المَساءُ، كانَ هُناكَ وَحْدَهُ. وكانَتِ السَفينةُ في وسَطِ البَحْرِ تَكُدُها الأَمْواجُ، لأَنَ الريحَ كانَتْ مُضادَّةً لها. وعِنْدَ الهَجْعَةِ الرابِعَةِ مِنَ الليلِ، مَضَى إلَيْهِمْ ماشِياً على البَحْرِ. فَلَمَّا رَآهُ التَلاميذُ ماشِياً على البَحْرِ، الشَّعِلَّةِ على البَحْرِ، الْمُواجُ، لأَنَ الريحَ كانَتْ مُضادَةً ومِنَ الخَوْفِ صَرَخُوا. فَلِلْوَقْتِ كَلَّمَهُمْ يَسوعُ قائِلاً: "ثِقُوا، أَنا هُوَ، لا تَخافوا." فَأَجَابَهُ بُطْرُسُ قائِلاً: "يا رَبُّ، إنْ كُنْتَ أَنْتَ هُوَ، فَمُرْني وَمِنَ النَّيَ على المِياهِ." فَقالَ: "تعالَ." فَنَزَلَ بُطْرُسُ مِنَ السَفينَةِ، ومَشى على المِياهِ آتِياً إلى يسوع. فَلَمّا رَأى شِدَّةَ الريح، خاف، وإذْ بَدَأ يَعْرَقُ، صاحَ قائِلاً: "يا رَبُّ نَجِّني!" ولِلْوَقْتِ مَدَّ يَسوعُ يَدَهُ وأَمْسَكَ بِهِ، وقالَ لهُ: "يا قليلَ الإيمانِ، لِماذا شَكَكْتَ؟" ولَمَّا دَخَلا والسَفينَة وسَجَدوا لَهُ قائِلينَ: "بالحَقيقَةِ أَنْتَ ابْنُ اللهِ." ولَمَّا عَبَروا، جاءوا إلى أرْضِ حَنِّسارَت

Metropolitan Anthony of Sourozh WEEKLY WE COME TO CHURCH

After a week which we spend in the twilight of the world, where the powers of good and the powers of evil are in contest, when we are called to be the light of the world, the salt that prevents its corruption, a living message that God has come, that victory over evil is won, and all hopes are possible, indeed all things are in the power of the Lord Jesus Christ who is our strength — after a whole week in this twilight we come to church, and it is a moment when two things should happen. It is a moment when we re-dedicate ourselves to God, because we bring at the same time in the Holy Liturgy two kinds of gifts. On the one hand, the offering of our souls and bodies, the gift of ourselves which should be unreserved, which we give according to our strength, but a strength that should grow day after day by the exercise of loyalty and faithfulness to God. And we also bring to God a sacrifice, an offering so holy and so perfect, the life and the death of the Lord Jesus Christ, His Resurrection and His Ascension into Heaven, and the vision of what we are called to be — all of us together with all things created. Because it is not only mankind whom God has assumed in Christ through the Incarnation — it is all things visible and invisible; the invisible through His Divinity in the human soul, and the visible by His Incarnation, by God taking flesh and becoming mysteriously and wonderfully akin to all that is material, visible, tangible. All creation, not only saints and sinners, but all things created can look at Christ's Body and rejoice because in Him they can see themselves in glory.

When we come to God we expect a gift of grace, the power of life to be poured into us so that we should become truly new creatures; not only creatures of flesh and blood, not only created beings standing face to face with their Creator but also creatures, pervaded by the power and the presence, the true communion with God which is given to us in the Sacraments.

It is only to the extent to which we bring ourselves as an offering (let it be earthen vessels open to receive things Holy) that we can receive these Holy things. In the prayer that precedes the consecration of the Holy Gifts the priest says: «Renew us who pray to Thee, and make this bread the Body of Christ, and this cup — the Blood of Christ». It is only to the extent to which we give ourselves to God to be filled, to the extent which we empty ourselves of all things contrary to Him, in intention, at least in the struggle which should be ours, that we can receive the gift.

But this gift is not given to us alone; it is not given to us that we should hug it, possess it, delight in it: it is given to us in the way in which a lamp is lit, in which a fire is lighted, in which the truth is given. Thanks be to God — we are not a body of people, prisoners of our buildings and our small frail Christian society! We are indeed sent into the world to be God's own witnesses, through Communion to the Body and Blood of Christ to be His incarnate presence. When we receive Communion we expect all things from God, but He also expects all things from us.

Let us ponder on this. Let us receive with an open heart and an open mind, with all our being, what God gives us, not in order to possess it but in order to give it, to give it as generously as God gives Himself: life and death, our joy and our sorrow, our broken-heartedness and our hopes — all to be given in God's Name to anyone who needs it. Then we shall have fulfilled the Apostle's call: «Carry one another's burdens, and so you shall have fulfilled the law of Christ».

سبع خبرات محورية في الغلبة على الخوف بالإيمان

درّب يسوعُ تلاميذَه على مواجهة الأخطار والصعاب بروح الإيمان الواثق به، وهم تعلّموا ذلك بفضل دروس كثيرة، كما في حادثة إبحارهم في بحيرة طبريّا عندما جاء يسوع إليهم ماشيًا على المياه وأنقذهم من العاصفة. فما هي الخبرات التي اختزنتها الكنيسة من تلك الحادثة؟

الخبرة الأولى هي الإبحار بأمر من يسوع. ترك يسوغ تلاميذه يبحرون من دونه، بينما انهمك هو في صرف الجموع بعد معجزة تكثير الخبز، وانفرد بعدها وحده ليصلّي على الجبل. كان إبحار التلاميذ في المركب وحدهم من دون المعلّم امتحانًا لهم ولما اكتسبوه من مرافقتهم له والاستماع إلى تعليمه ومعاينة عجائبه. هكذا يصلب عود التلاميذ بتدرّبهم على حمل وديعة الإيمان كلّ بحسب موقع مسؤوليّته وتبعًا لظروف خدمته.

الخبرة الثانية هي مواجهة الشدائد والأخطار خلال الإبحار. واجه التلاميذ خطر الإبحار في بحيرة طبريّا وسط العاصفة الهوجاء. من الضروريّ على التلميذ أن يكتسب الحكمة الإلهيّة عبر خبرات كثيرة ويتعلّم ترجمتها على أرض الواقع في تدبير شؤون الحياة المختلفة. وشكّلت الحادثة التي نحن في صددها خبرة محوريّة في الكنيسة الأولى، وخلال أزمنة الاضطهاد المختلفة وغذّت حكمتُها المؤمنين وشدّدتهم في محنهم كأشخاص وجماعة على السّواء.

الخبرة الثالثة تكمن في التأكيد على وجود يسوع في عين العاصفة. لم يكن يسوع لا بعيدًا ولا غريبًا عن معاناة تلاميذه. بينما سادهم الخوف سواء بداعي الخطر الخارجي المحدق بهم أو بظهور يسوع ماشيًا على المياه، ظهر يسوع سيّدًا على قوى الطبيعة، عسى سلامه يسود في قلوبهم. كيف السبيل إلى ذلك؟ بالإيمان به، بالاتّكال على معيّته، وبالاستناد إلى قدرته، باتباع كلمته وأمره، كما ظهر في خلاصة الحادثة.

الخبرة الرابعة هي إمكانية الانطلاق دومًا نحو المسيح مهما كانت الأخطار أو شدّة العاصفة. نعم، الإمكانية متوفّرة دائمًا للدخول مرّة وأخرى في خبرة الإصغاء إلى المعلّم والمبادرة إليه بشكل يستلهم مبادرته إلينا. إنها حركة داخليّة لاستعادة الإيمان به في عين العاصفة: «تشجّعوا! أنا هو. لا تخافوا» (متّى ١٤: ٢٧). التقط بطرسُ مبادرة يسوع وطلب إذنه بأن يحاكي خبرته، بالذهاب إليه ماشيًا على المياه كما هو أتى إليهم. لقد وضع البوصلة الصحيحة لنفسه ليمشي بهديها.

الخبرة الخامسة هي التوبة بعد سقوط. تغلّب بطرس على الخوف بالإيمان، لكنه عاد وترك الخوف يسود عليه عندما استرسل في التمعّن في المخاطر فغيّب يسوع عن مجال رؤيته الداخليّة. بفقدانه السيطرة على نفسه و على واقعه بآن، كانت صلاتُه من كلّ قلبه حبل نجاته و فرصته الجديدة-الأخيرة: «يا ربّ، نجّني» (متّى ١٤: ٣٠). تاب إلى يسوع وترك الكلمة الفصل للقادر على أن ينجّيه.

الخبرة السادسة هي حقيقة الخلاص في الكنيسة. حصل بطرس على إنقاذ مزدوج: من جهة، اليد الممدودة لإنقاذه من الغرق، ومن جهة أخرى، تنبيه يسوع لإنقاذه من شكّه وقلّة إيمانه: «بيا قليل الإيمان، لماذا شككت؟» (متّى ١٤: ٣١). صوّب يسوع الاتّجاه نحو معالجة الواقع المادّيّ.

الخبرة السابعة هي عبادة الإله الحقيقي. «الذين في السفينة جاؤوا وسجدوا له قائلين: «بالحقيقة أنت ابن الله»» (متّى ١٤: ٣٣). فتقديم العبادة لله، بالسجود للمسيح والاعتراف به، يشكّل الإكليل الذي يتوّج خبرة عبورنا في هذا العالم مع يسوع وفي كنيسته، وهو أيضًا يشكّل المحرِّك الذي يوجّه من الآن فصاعدًا خبرتنا في الإبحار وسط العالم، في سفينة الكنيسة وعلى أمواج الته بة

انتهت الحادثة بأن حلّت السكينة في البحيرة وفي نفوس التلاميذ بصعود يسوع مع بطرس إلى السفينة. الغلبة على الخوف والاضطراب بسيادة الإيمان كرزت به الكنيسة عبر العصور، وقدّمتها في باقة هذه الخبرات السبع و عكستها في خدمتها وشهادتها في مراحل عبور أعضائها وانطلاقهم من هذا الدهر إلى الدهر الآتي، حيث السكينة في الميناء والمعيّة في العبادة والشركة في الله بعد شراكة إيمانيّة في مواجهة الصعاب. فهل تتمخّض أزماتنا بأن تنشئ فينا هذا التوجّه الإنجيليّ وتبرز فينا هذه القامة الروحيّة وتُعلي بيننا هذه الشهادة لعمل الله فينا؟ هذا رجاؤنا، اليوم وكلّ يوم، ونراه معجونًا في قلوب مؤمنة وخادمة ومصلّية. فشكرًا لله على هذه الخميرة الصالحة التي نرجو أن تخمّر العجين كلّه!
